18:15-18:45 The Adult autism cohort UK: Experiences of setting up the cohort studies, and some initial findings



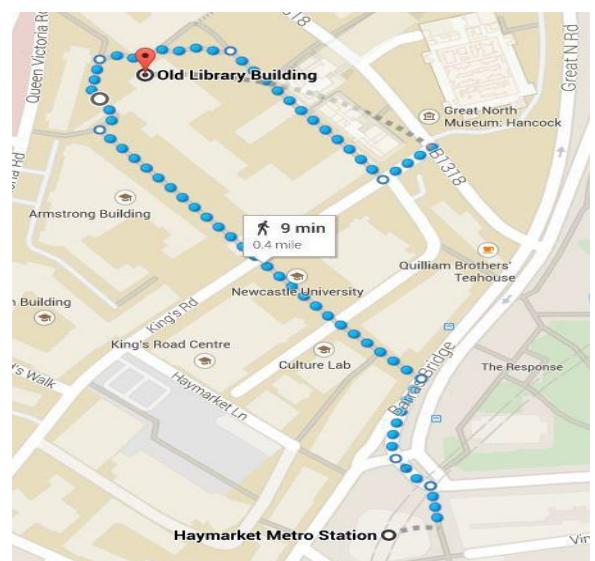
