

HEALTHY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

AGE 60+

We are looking for healthy volunteers for a medical research study who:

- Are aged over 60 and consider themselves healthy.
- Have never had the Pneumovax (pneumonia) vaccine

This is a study looking to see how older people's immune system responds to a vaccine.

Participation would involve three / four visits to the RVI hospital over the course of a month. Participants can take part in either group 1 or group 2 of the study.

In group 1 people would give a blood sample at each visit, in addition to having the Pneumovax vaccine at the first visit. Those people in group 2 would have a blood sample at each visit but also a camera test of the lungs on the second and third visits, as well as having the Pneumovax vaccine at the second visit.

Participants will be paid a fee to compensate for time and inconvenience.
