

# HEALTHY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

## AGE 60+

We are looking for volunteers for a medical research study who:

- Are aged 60 or over
- Do not currently smoke cigarettes (including on any occasions in past year)
- Have either never smoked cigarettes or smoked for under 2 years
- Do not currently use e-cigarettes
- Use minimal regular medications
  - Certain medications are allowed for the trial including aspirin, paracetamol, certain blood pressure tablets, HRT, and medications for acid reflux and underactive thyroid.

This is an innovative study into lung health and immunity.

Participants will visit the RVI or Freeman hospital over 4 consecutive days. The first three will be brief visits involving screening, blood taking and the inhalation of a medication or placebo. The fourth visit involves a camera examination of your lungs called a bronchoscopy, for which you would spend a few hours in the hospital.

The aim of the study is for all participants to return after 1-3 months to repeat the tests.

Participants will be paid a fee to compensate for time and inconvenience. A further payment will be given after the repeat tests.
