Members Location

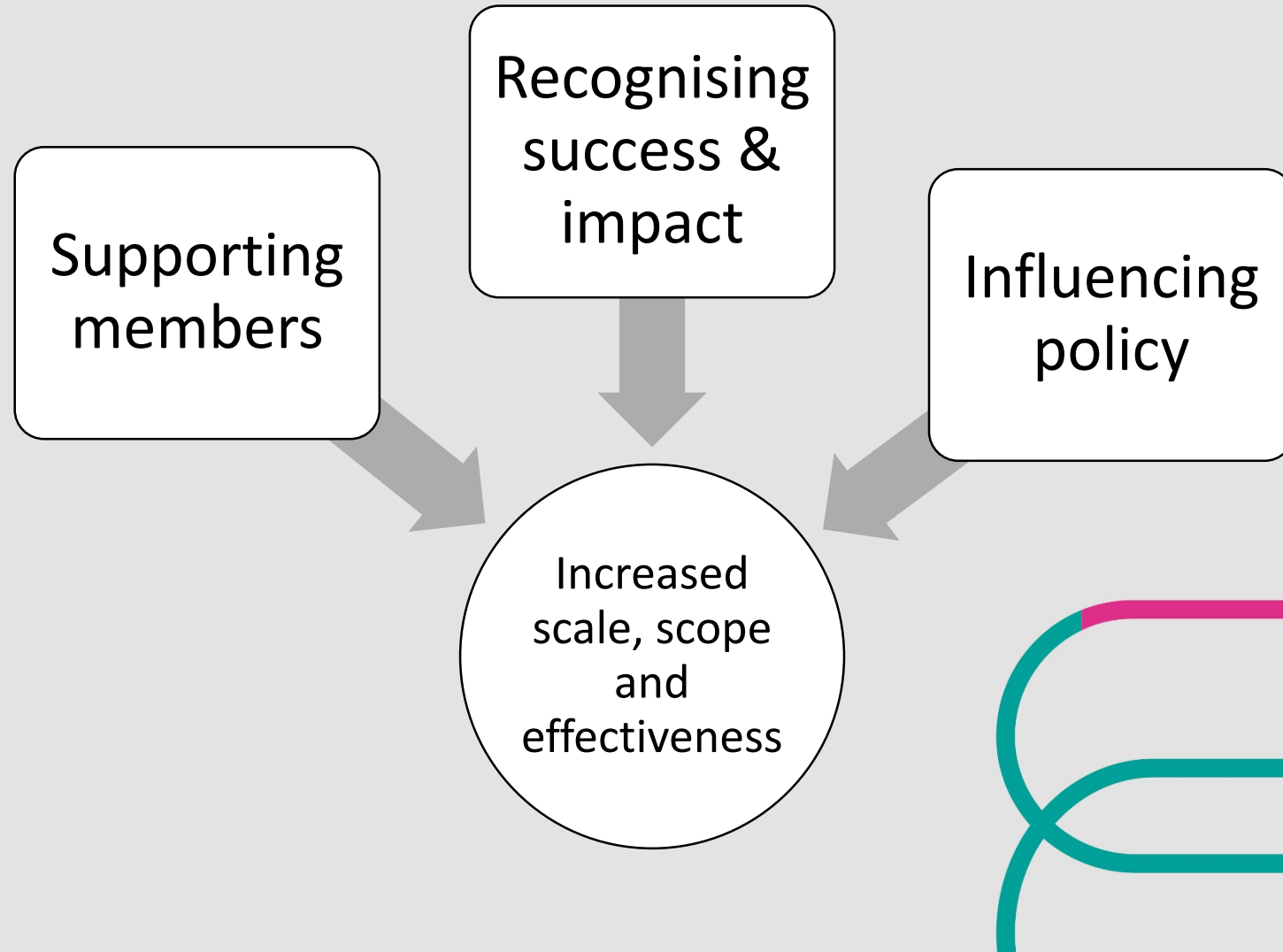


EEUK Members Map

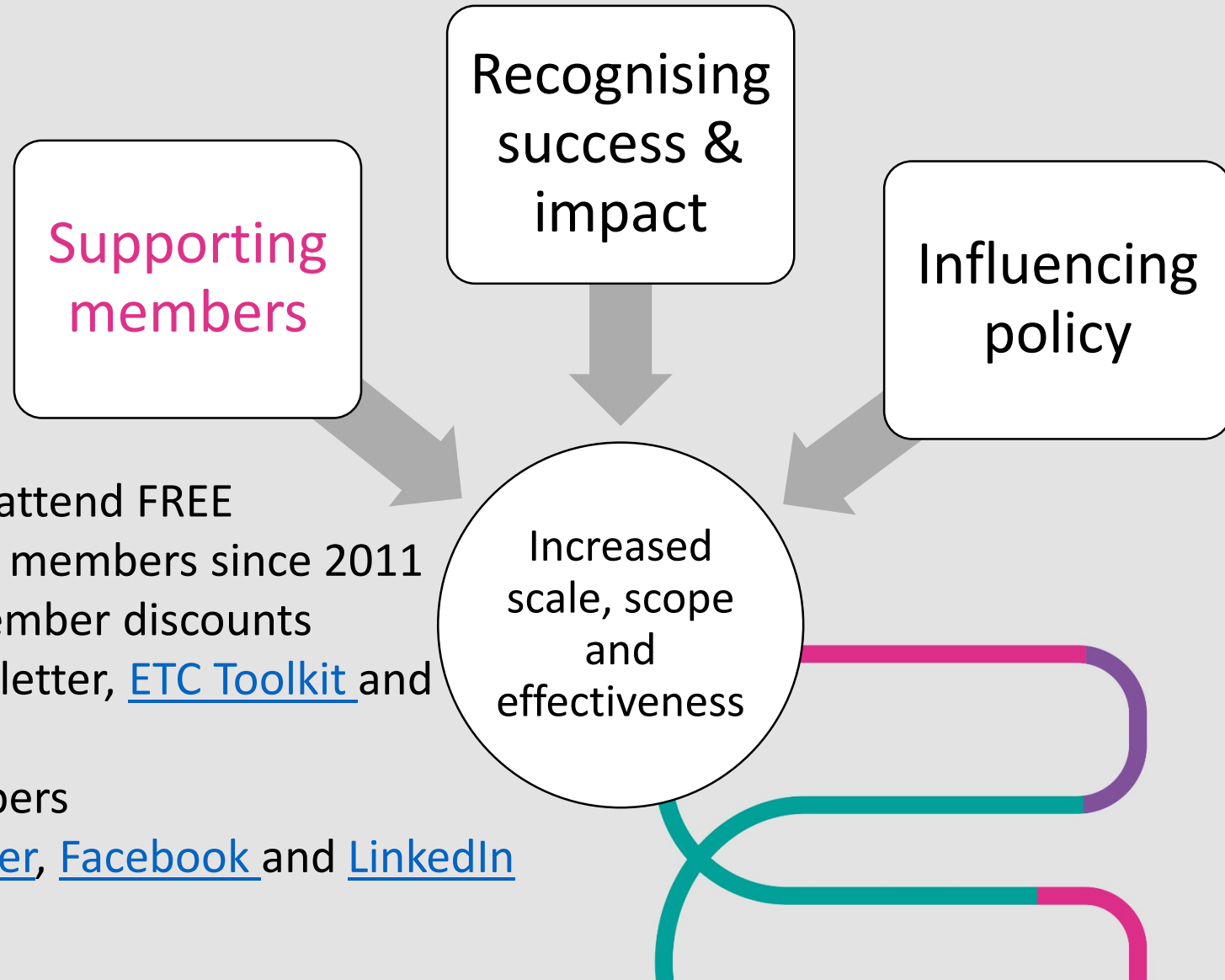
