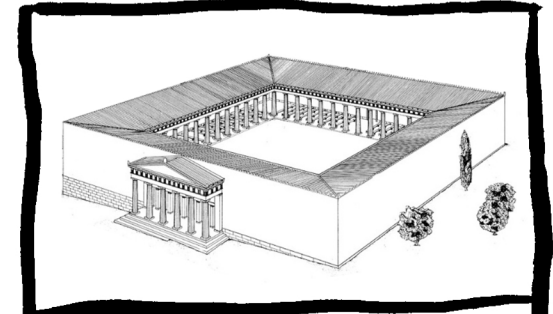
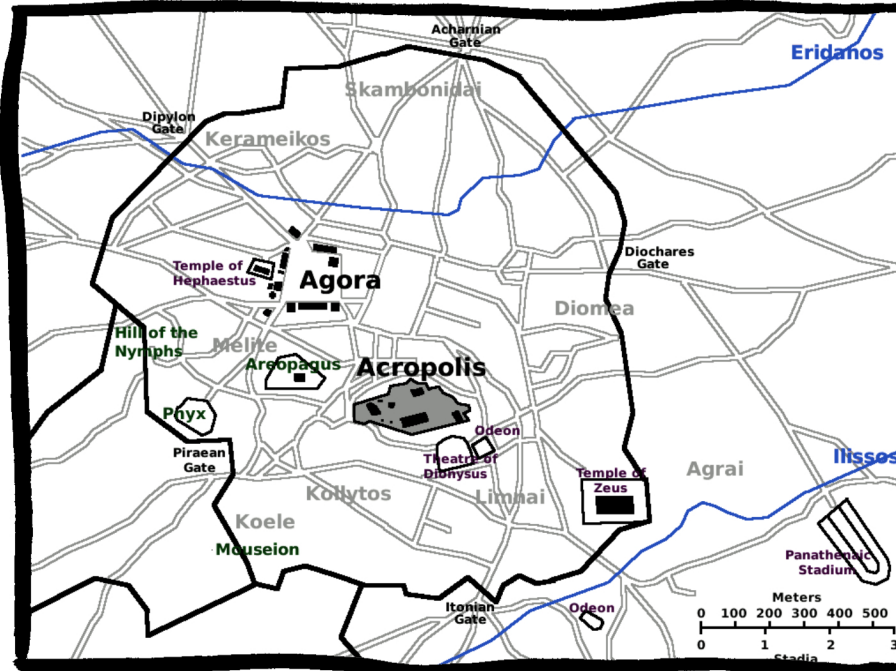


ANCIENT ATHENS AND DEMOCRACY

Find the location for each picture on the map and draw an arrow to it.



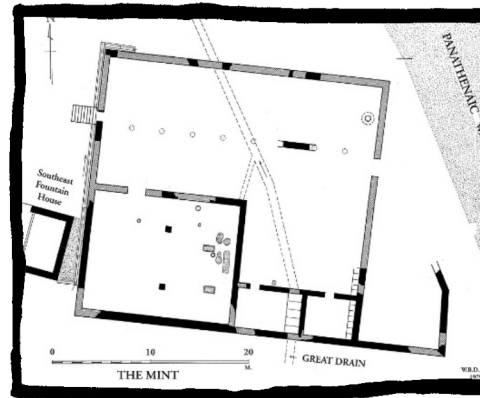
The rock in the front of the picture is the Areopagus with a view to the Acropolis. It was the meeting place of the council of elders.
