

Equipment:

- Soft Fimo (white)
- Bottle tops (for cutting)
- Tools
- Alphabet stamps: A, O, E (cookie cutters)
- Silver Fimo powder
- Paintbrushes
- Trays
- Foil or baking paper
- Worksheet: Designing a Greek Coin



Instructions:

- Divide the Fimo into small balls.
- Roll the Fimo into a ball and squash down with a hand until it is around 4mm thick.
- Cut out with a bottle top.
- Use tools or a pencil to add the design.
- Both sides can be decorated but there is a danger of squashing the first design if you press too hard!
- The stamps can be used to add the letters (press firmly) or they can be done by hand.
- Put the coins onto trays to add the silver powder to both sides with a paintbrush – you really do not need much powder at all!
- The coins then need baking to harden them.



Guidance for Baking:

Place the coins on foil or baking paper and let them harden in a preheated oven for maximum of 30 minutes at 110°C or 230°F.

The coins will harden completely as they cool.
