A chous is a specific type of jug. They were used to pour water or wine.

These jugs, especially small examples measuring between 5-20cm in height, seem to have been used by children and are very often decorated with scenes showing children doing a variety of things.

More than 1000 examples have been found from across the Greek world, though they are most common in Athens.

They were used at a special festival where young children would have their first drink of wine.
