

# Design a Chous

In this activity, we are thinking about the following object(s):  
Chous 198



Scenes on little chous jugs show children, they are often playing; alone, with animals, with toys, and in groups. They can also be just sitting – like on the Shefton chous 198 – or they can be crawling. The children often have objects with them in the scenes. Some of the ‘attributes’ (things) children are shown with most often are little jugs, rollers or small cart toys, cakes, balls, dogs, grapes and birds.

**In this activity, you can design your own chous, on the outline below: you can use some of the common attributes printed at the bottom, cutting them out and sticking them onto the chous. You can also add some other things by drawing them onto the chous yourself. You may want to draw in pencil first, until you are happy with your design, and then go over the lines in a black fine-liner. You can also add colour; red for the figure and the border, for example.**
