Pick whichever one you like the most, don't be shy.

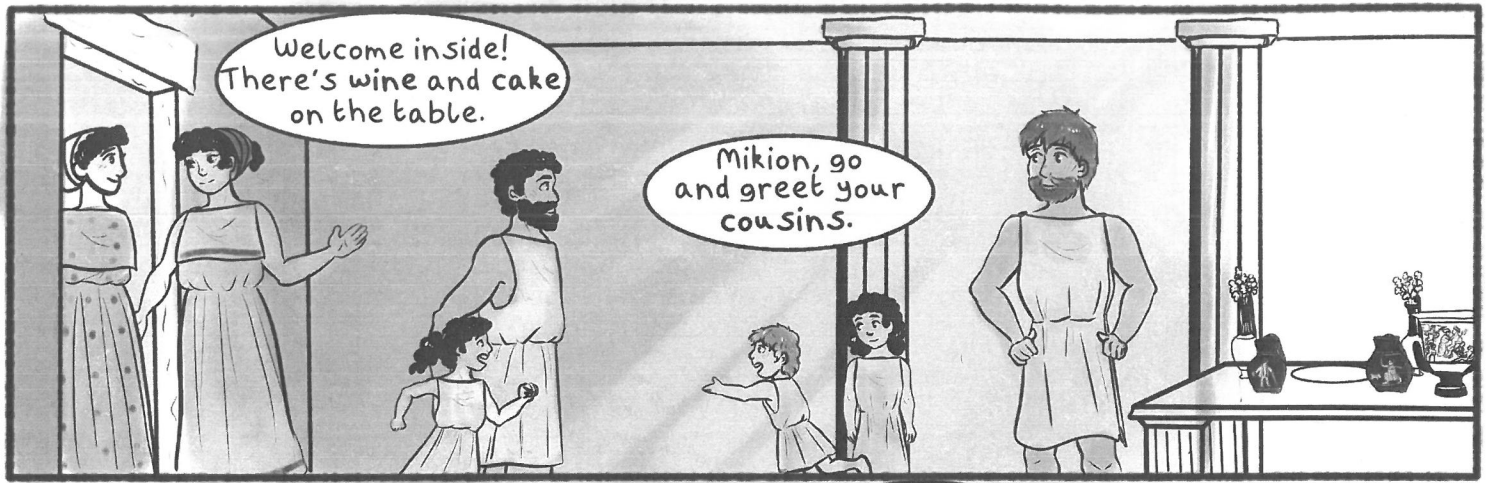


Papa, can I have this one?

Of course, son! Let's take it home and help everyone

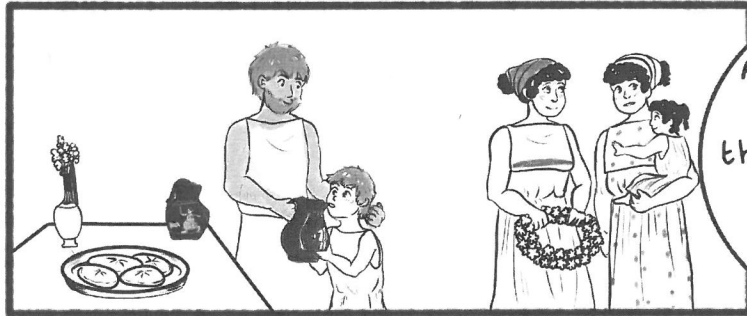
to finish decorating the house for the party.

cousins.



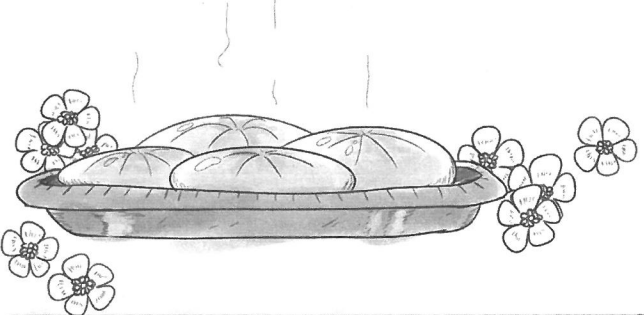
For today's

their special chous.



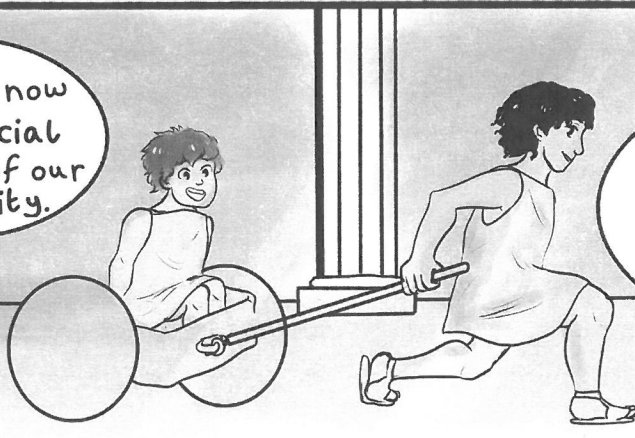
Then, we'll
