Interview with Kathern Cunningham Our new Qualitative Researcher



As we near the end of the trial it is time to start crunching the numbers.

In February, our new Qualitative Researcher Kathryn Joins the team.

Here's what she had to say.

What interested you to apply for the job?

"I like working in new areas of research and I haven't worked in oral health before. The FiCTION trial sounded like a very interesting and worthwhile study"

What was your background before joining the FiCTION team?

"I completed a degree in Psychology at the University of St. Andrews in 2008. I then worked at the University of Edinburgh as a Research Assistant on an RCT of a psychological therapy for depression in people with cancer, before completing my PhD at the University of Dundee in the area of loneliness and cancer in 2014. During my PhD I held research positions in cancer care, cardiac rehabilitation and intensive care. Since completing my PhD I have been working on an intervention development study in the area of alcohol and men's health at the University of Dundee"

Can you tell us more about qualitative research, and what is hoped to be achieved with FiCTION?

"Qualitative research differs from quantitative research in its function and therefore in its methods of sampling, data collection and data analysis. It is fundamentally exploratory and aims to describe, understand and explain. In the FiCTION trial we plan to conduct qualitative interviews with children and parents to explore the acceptability of the three treatment strategies. We also plan to undertake qualitative interviews and/or focus groups with dental teams to explore the treatment strategy preferences of dentists and dental team members (so we'll be looking for participants in a few months!). This part of the study is important as a treatment strategy could be extremely effective and cost-effective, however if it is not acceptable to patients and/or parents they will likely refuse it, and if there are barriers to implementation on the side of the dental team these may prevent the strategy from being employed. It is therefore essential to explore these issues in addition to the effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of the three treatment strategies."

What are you looking forward to most on the trial?

"Meeting and interviewing the children, parents and dentists participating in the trial"

Will there be any challenges?

"Interviewing young children. I'm looking forward to it though"

What do you do outside of work to relax?

"I enjoy spending time with family and friends. I have an 8-month old daughter so don't have much time for hobbies at the moment. But I still manage to fit in some netball and running!"

Kathryn will support the FiCTION trial with primarily qualitative data collection and analysis, mainly through interviews and focus group work.


