

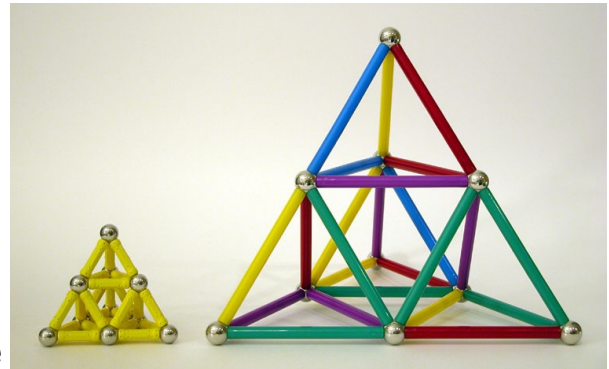
Geomag



As well as developing two-handed play this game gives the helper hand practice in:

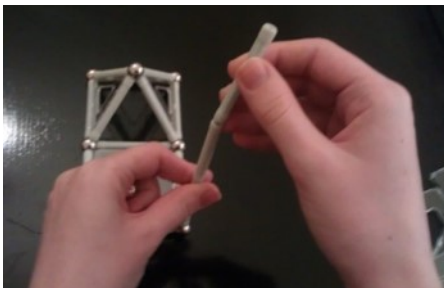
- Thumb/finger grasping
- Holding
- Reaching
- Releasing

There are lots of different sets available e.g. Geomag Color, Pink, Panels, Glitter, Mechanics, Construction etc.



Ask your child to place the white box and bag of plastic fittings on the table beside him/her.

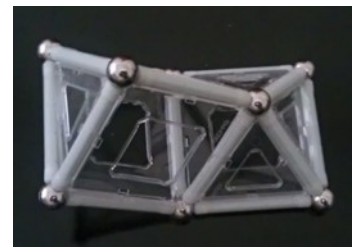
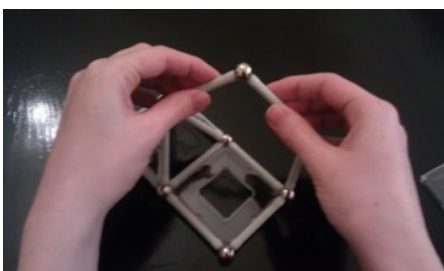
Try to make sure they are on his/her helper side to encourage your child to reach for them with his/her helper hand.



The magnetic sticks can be connected together, either directly or with a silver ball in between.

Your child can make whatever shape structure he/she likes, there are some ideas on the leaflet in the box.

Your child might also like to add some plastic panels to make his/her structure more solid. These will slot in between the magnetic sticks.



Your child should hold them between his/her fingers and gently work them into the space where he/she wants to put them.

There are all sorts of things that your child could make with the Geomag, so have fun!
