As well as developing two-handed play this game gives the helper hand practice in:

Thumb/finger grasping Holding Reaching Releasing

For this game, encourage your child to use both hands.

Place the tile pieces on your child's helper side to begin with to encourage him/her to pick them up with that hand.

Encourage your child to use his her helper hand to keep the tile steady on the table while he/she decorates the tile with the other hand. Your child will also need to hold the tile with one hand to attach the magnet to the back using the other hand.

The little pots of paint might be difficult to open the first time so you may need to help your child with that.

Encourage your child to try to open them from here on.
