

Noggin bops! (wind-up toy)



This is a good thing to have around to practise two-handed play.

It gives the helper hand practice in grasping and holding.

Your child should hold the little robot in the helper hand and use the dominant hand to wind it up.

If that is too difficult, he/she can put the robot on the table and use the helper hand to keep it steady while the dominant hand winds it up.

The robot will do a little dance!
