Creating a PhD One Planet application for Newcastle University

This guide is to help you complete the first sections of the Newcastle University application form, so you can provide the required information for your PhD One Planet application.


Please 'Create a new account' in the Apply to Newcastle Portal.

Once this is done you can create an application using the option in the blue bar at the top of the screen:



Complete the 'Applicant's Personal Information' page and then proceed to the 'Course Choice' page.

Select the Search Course button and you will be shown the below drop-down options. Please complete the 'Type of study', 'Year of Entry' and the 'Course Title' sections (please note, in the 'Course Title' field you can input either the course code, 8212F, or enter the keywords One Planet). Please leave the 'Research Area' field blank. Press the search button and it should find the PhD One Planet programme.



Once you have selected the PhD One Planet course please press the 'Further Details' button:

If you are applying for a Postgraduate Research Programme with different studentships, please search and add the programme multiple times. Please use the Further Details to then provide the studentship/research title you are considering for the programme.

This will open the 'Additional Questions' section where you can input the One Planet project code for the project you would like to apply for e.g. OP2366. You should also input the project title and give the Supervisor name.

Please note, if you are outlining your own research idea please use the project code OP9000.

Before submitting your application, you will be required to attach the following supporting documents:

- An up-to-date CV/resume
- Your 1,000-word personal statement (with your chosen project title and reference code e.g. OP23XX). Please explain how your knowledge, skills and experience fit the project outline.
- Your 1,000-word project proposal (with project title and reference code OP23XX). If you are outlining your own research idea please use reference code OP9000
- A minimum of two references. These can be submitted with your application if
 they are signed, or alternatively, they can be emailed directly by the referee
 to <u>oneplanet@ncl.ac.uk</u> Please note that it is your responsibility to request
 these references and ensure they that are sent to us.
- Attach degree transcripts and certificates.
- If English is not your first language, a copy of your English language qualification
