Purpose of this paper (please also indicate whether empirical, conceptual or case study etc) - Rural social entrepreneurship is usually seen as a solution to problems in rural development through rural mobilization and stagnating rural are expected to return to growth. the question of what social entrepreneurship is and how it emerges remains unanswered or neglected. the purpose of our case study is tried to answer this question and reveal the rural social entrepreneurial process from Meinong rural in Taiwan.

Design/methodology/approach (including limitations if applicable) - A general overview the problems of rural areas and their manifestation in the case study of Meinong in Taiwan is followed by the narratives of social entrepreneurs's storytelling of their experience.
