Data notes and coding

Coding of open-ended questions: Responses to open-ended questions were coded (given numerical codes/categorised) using a questionnaire coding instructions protocol.

General coding instructions

Responses of Yes and No

Throughout the questionnaire a "yes" response is coded as 1 and a "no" response is coded as 2. 1=Yes, 2=No

Missing values

Missing values are left blank and become dots(.) in the data file. See also coding notes for individual questions.

Data notes:

The original data file contained a duplicate record for serial number 226174. The records were identical except that one record/questionnaire had not been coded.

Therefore, the record which had not been coded was deleted manually.
