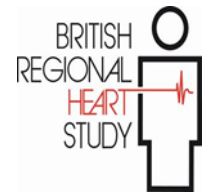

Baseline examination 1978-80 (Q1)

They include:

1. The town from which the participant was recruited at baseline in 1978-80 (Q1)
2. Examination date of the baseline physical examination and completion of the questionnaire
3. Time of the physical examination
4. Age at the 1978-80 baseline examination
5. Social class based on longest held occupation
6. Socio-Economic Group (SEG)

2. Social class

Information collected from the Baseline (1978-80) questionnaire (question 4.4) on the longest-held occupation was coded to one of the Registrar General's six social classes, using the 1970 OPCS manual for occupational classification.

4 = III Manual
5 = IV
6 = V
8 = HMF Armed forces
9 = Missing

- (1) Employers and managers in central and local government, industry, commerce, etc. -large establishments
- (2) Employers and managers in industry, commerce, etc. -small establishments
- (3) Professional workers – self-employed
- (4) Professional workers – employees
- (5) Intermediate non-manual workers
- (6) Junior non-manual workers
- (7) Personal service workers
- (8) Foremen and supervisors – manual
- (9) Skilled manual workers
- (10) Semi-skilled manual workers
- (11) Unskilled manual workers
- (12) Own account workers (other than professional)
- (13) Farmers – employers and managers
- (14) Farmers – own account
- (15) Agricultural workers
- (16) Members of armed forces
- (17) Occupation inadequately described
