## NATTINA Recruitment update

December and January have both been great months for recruitment with 14 recruited in December and 11 in January. Congratulations to Newcastle, Aberdeen, Glasgow, Bradford, Dundee, Birmingham, Sheffield, Nottingham, Ayrshire and Oxford on your successful recruitment of participants but thank you to ALL sites for their continued hard work on the NATTINA study.

As of 31st January 2018, we have recruited 417 participants into NATTINA!

## Keep going!

The recruitment end date has now been extended to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2018 to allow us to ensure we recruit as many participants as possible to make the results of the study as robust as possible. There are a number of sites that are close to their recruitment targets, so with continued effort are on course to hit those before recruitment closes.

## Important Info

#### SOHO66 Fax Numbers

We currently have two SOHO66 fax numbers — one for SAE reporting, which has a larger distribution list including study sponsor, and one for sites to send confidential participant information including consent forms and contact details forms, which only comes to the relevant members of staff within NCTU who require this information for monitoring purposes.

Sites are reminded to make sure they are using the correct SOHO66 fax number when faxing through participant information to us to ensure that only those necessary have access to this information. This is particularly important in light of forthcoming GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) legislation that will come in to force in May 2018. This new legislation means that sponsor must report any data breaches and may incur a fine as a result of a data breach.
