NATTINA Recruitment update

February has been another great month for recruitment with 14 participants consented and randomised. Congratulations to Aberdeen, Glasgow, Dundee, Wigan, Nottingham, Ayrshire and Oxford on your successful recruitment of participants but thank you to ALL sites for their continued hard work on the NATTINA study and continuing to carry out clinics and screening. The recruitment end date is now 30/04/2018 so plenty more time for sites to get a few more participants.

As of 28th February 2018, we have recruited 431 participants into NATTINA!

Completion of Study Visits

A quick reminder to sites regarding the importance of ensuring all study visits are conducted for each participant in line with protocol requirements (and that all data is entered in MACRO In a timely manner) to ensure completeness of data within the study. This is particularly important as it ensures that the data available for analysis at the end of the study is as complete as possible and will help to generate high quality results.
