Consultation Process

The reports for the various exemplar issues have been the subject of considerable consultation. Small working groups were involved in the production of the reports and views have been sought from these members and other report recipients. Consultation on the exemplar issue Quality Protects took place at a special meeting of the HAZ Looked After Children Group and is incorporated in the Quality Protects Report. The results of the consultation on the other exemplar issues are embodied in the three reports outlined below.

As a major part of the consultation process of this project, a consultation workshop (Information into Action) was held on 28th September 2001 based on three of the exemplar issues (Low Birthweight, Cerebral Palsy and Serious Injury). These topics were chosen as key issues to meet national targets. The <u>Meeting Report</u> consists of the discussions and workshop outcomes.

An in-depth consultation has taken place for one of the exemplar issues (Cerebral Palsy) demonstrating how health related needs of children, as perceived by them and/or their parents, compare with the perception and provision of major service providers. The <u>Cerebral Palsy Second Report</u> details this piece of research.

The final report, <u>Consultation Comments Report</u>, is an amalgamation of all the comments received throughout the consultation period.
