Welcome to the February 2017 BHF SENIOR-RITA newsletter.

We are pleased to say that to date we have conducted <u>17 SIVs and 13 sites</u> are open to active recruitment. 3 new sites opened this month so we welcome Dr Gerber and his team at East Sussex, Dr Carter and his team at North Tees and Dr Robertson and his team at Glasgow. Another 5 sites are very close to opening too

Congratulations this month go to <u>Dr. Cooke and team at Chesterfield</u> for recruiting their first three participants, <u>Dr. Aggarwal and team at Essex</u> and <u>Dr Justin Carter and team at North Tees</u> for both recruiting their first two participants and <u>Dr Gerber and team at East Sussex</u> for recruiting their first participant.

The recruitment is certainly picking up momentum. In total, there have been 11 participants recruited this month making our total recruitment to date of 25 participants. We are in the process of adding further sites to bring our total number of SENIOR-RITA sites to 30.

## SCREENING AND PATIENT RECRUITMENT STRATEGIES

## Our recruitment target is 2300. With all your help and support we can achieve this!

- 1. We request where feasible the research team to approach all 75 and over patients presenting with **NSTEMI**
- 2. We request that all clinical teams, Medical Admissions, CCU, Cardiology wards including junior doctors are made aware of SENIOR-RITA trial at your sites so that eligible patients and their relatives are given an opportunity to consider SENIOR-RITA before a management decision is made
- 3. With our overall target of 2300 patients, we request that each site recruit a minimum of 2-3 patients/month to meet our overall target in time. Of course, more patients are very welcome!
- 4. If patients randomized to conservative arm were to develop significant symptoms post randomization, further treatment including invasive care is at the discretion of the treating Cardiologist and any further events will be captured as an outcome measure.
- 5. If patient carers are not available, then the carer aspect of the trial are not mandated.
