Welcome to the March 2017 BHF SENIOR-RITA newsletter and what a busy month we have had!



OTHER INFORMATION FOR SITES

- Important to check that the participants have received all the appropriate medication & that sites follow the routine pathway and that they are seen by the cardiac rehabilitation team
- Screening logs we are aware there has been some confusion over the screening logs. The
 electronic screening log is compulsory and must be completed for all people approached,
 whether they are recruited or not. The paper screening log provided in the Investigator Site
 File is optional. However please note that Sites must continue to manually complete the
 Patient Identification Code List in their site file.
